WHO ARE WE?

SIGN UP FOR OUR MAILING LIST!

Currently, it is our most efficient way to communicate important action alerts. No junk or spam emails. Only relevant information, like your Precinct Contact list, will be sent to keep our Patriot community organized and motivated to support Conservative causes and candidates.

WHAT TO DO NOW!

1. Find Your Precinct

- Go to your County website. Using your home address, find your Precinct Number and Assembly District. While you're at it, find your Congressional and Senate District as well.
- For example, If you are in LA County, go to lavote.net. If in Orange County, go to ocvote.net

2. Get a copy of your Precinct / Walk List

- Go to your County website and find your Assembly District # and the committee already in place
- Politely ask your Assembly Chair for a copy of your Precinct "walking" List. Inform them politely that you are a Volunteer and ready to work your Precincts.
- Educate yourself. Learn the meaning of the important symbols and codes on the Precinct list. For example: R (Republican), DS (Decline to State), NPP (No Party Preference), D (DemoncRAT)
- See #6 below and familiarize yourself with the structure of the State and County party. You are the INFORMED Republican face of your Precinct. As first GOP point of contact, Know your stuff!

3. Meet your local Conservative Republican or DS Neighbors

- With the Precinct List in hand, start with your own block. Find your local allies. Take your time. Introduce yourself as a fellow Conservative Republican in the neighborhood.
- Give them your contact information immediately.
- Start the conversation very casually..."I really want to meet like-minded people in the area so we can support each other with community concerns". Or more generally, "I really like your flag...or "Did your kids go to (neighborhood school)"...or "Did you hear..."

4. Develop a Relationship with your Conservative Republican neighbors

- Republicans like knowing they are NOT alone in the neighborhood. Encourage them to communicate with you regarding their concerns and interests. Be a sounding board.
- When you have established familiarity with your neighbors, host regular get togethers at your supporter's houses, at the park, at a local eatery, etc.
- Make certain you have EVERYONE's contact data.
- Be consistent and Make it FUN!

5. Create an online TELEGRAM App Account for your Patriot Precinct

- Why Telegram? Because it is the most secure and effective way to stay in touch
- This will be the first step to formalizing your group. With this tool you can communicate in real time, especially with urgent messages or action alerts.
- By now, you will have identified your biggest supporter(s) in the neighborhood. They are the ones as excited and "ready to go' as you are.
- Start to delegate some of your tasks, like managing the Telegram account.

6. Unite your Voice (VOTE)

- As the Patriot Republican Precinct Leader, please stay informed with the state of your city and county.
- Be aware of who your City Council members are, especially your City District.
- Learn who your State Representatives are: Assembly, Senate, Congress
- And if you have children, knowing who your School Board members are is critical.
- But most importantly, be aware of the urgent issues of your neighborhood and city, particularly laws that directly affect you and your neighbors.
- During Election cycles, review candidate platforms and UNITE. Support the conservative candidate.
- Vocally support your conservative advocacies by attending City Council meetings regularly. Encourage your Precinct patriots to join you.

7. Expand and Invite

 Help expand this effort by telling Patriots in other Precincts about the website and how to GET STARTED. Share the website and Telegram link to as many Patriot Groups you know and encounter.

8. Visit the EVENTS/KEY INITIATIVES/ACTION ITEMS Page Often

The Events page will have event flyers and announcements related to training and other pertinent
meetings or events. Key Initiatives and ACTION Items such as Election Integrity, Voter Registration,
Recall Action Support, Candidate Recruitment, Initiatives and Recommendations, will be posted on this
page.

9. Register your Precinct on the Official Website (PatriotPrecincts.com)

- Email us your Precinct Leader Contact Info, Precinct #, and Telegram Group link.
- This allows us to support your Precinct with networking resources and to streamline any urgent communication. Organization is Key to our effort in **Making California Conservative Again!**

BEYOND THE PRECINCT LEADER POSITION

As a Patriot Republican Volunteer, you can fulfill more than one responsibility. You can not only be an active Precinct Leader, you can also be appointed or elected to become part of YOUR Assembly District Committee. Or You can choose to be one or the other.

You can run for one of the elected positions in your Assembly District. In LA County, each Assembly District requires 7 Members (elected) positions and 7 Alternates (appointed). Any volunteer can also apply or be appointed as an Associate Member, which allows you to attend monthly AD meetings without voting privileges. Other Counties may have different number of Committee members requirements.

An AD member is voted for by the Republican voters in their Assembly District. They can also be Appointed by the Chair of that Assembly District. If there is no Assembly Chair, the County Chair can appoint you to become a Member.

Typically most appointees are known or familiar to the AD Committee. In cases where there are multiple vacancies and the Committee is effectively non-active, the Chair can take applications from interested parties with recommendations, and can appoint new Members for his Assembly District. All District Committee members must attend monthly AD meetings for strategy and policy making.

Each Member then becomes a voting member of the County Party. Members can attend the monthly County Central Committee meetings. The County Party have their own Central Committee consisting of the Executive Board (Chairman, 1st/2nd Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer, etc.).

- 3-Then recruit Conservative Republican Neighbors to help with grass roots info campaign

OBJECTIVES:

- 1-Educate your conservative neighbors on different viewpoint between conservative & Liberals.
- 2-Motivate conservative voters in your Precinct to vote on all local, state and National elections.
- 3-Motivate conservative voters in the precinct to keep aware of local and state leadership activities.

GOALS:

- 1-Organize conservative friends to Help get out the **vote** in every single local and state election
- 2-Become conversant on area boundaries of federal congressional, State Senate, State Assembly
- 3-Organize efforts in Recall vote of governor and get signatures to recall LA County DA Gascon.


RESPONSIBILITIES:

Become a part of the PATRIOT PRECINCT PROJECT

The following pages provide a guide of how you can make a difference in your own neighborhood with Conservative citizens. The purpose is to get our state and nation back on track to be great again, setting our sights on an America First agenda.

We invite you to apply for the precinct leader responsibility in the CA State Assembly district in which you live. It behooves you to consider becoming an Associate member as well.

We will provide you political source data to use for your specific neighborhood so you can be known as the friendly neighbor that can relay information on Republican focused activities in your area.


By <u>providing your voter registered name and address</u> we will request the Assembly District Chair in which you live to assign you precinct responsibilities in the neighborhood. Support data will be provided for your convenience.


- 1. The following is a brief introduction to the local and state Republican organization structure. It is followed by the example of data about the 3 political districts which you live, that you will need to learn about to be effective as precinct leader in your neighborhood.
- 2. Samples are attached for a specific area in a US Congressional district plus a CA Senate district and a CA Assembly district from the most current info online. You can begin immediately to gather data to educate your conservative neighbors how our political system works. You can refer to the individual voting info of every registered voter in your precinct as provided by your AD.
- 3. Our primary objective nationwide in 2022 is to take control of the US House and Senate. There are objectives in 2021 that need local volunteer help to begin now. In LA County we will be gathering signatures to Recall LA County District Attorney who's already working against law enforcement letting criminals roam our streets. The Special Election for a new Governor will be sometime in the Fall, 21.

4. The CA Political Organization and Structure

- **A. US Congressional districts**. Seats are assigned every 10 years after the census. They all have 2 year terms. CA has 53 assigned. Each has about 710,000 population. In CA, there are 11 congressional seats held by Republicans (6 new seats were won by the GOP in 2020).
- **B. State Senate districts**. There are total of 40 seats. Each are elected for four year terms. Half of these seats are up for election in 2022. Democrats have a super majority in the Senate as well. Republican objective for 2022 is to elect enough Republicans to break that super majority control.
- **C. State Assembly districts**. Seats are voted on every two years. 80 districts in CA total with 24 located, all or in part, in LA County. The Democrats hold super majority, (over 2/3rd), meaning they can override governor veto without Republican support. We recommend you go to the Wikipedia for each district to make your own current data for distribution and dissemination.

- 5. Please EMAIL to <u>info@patriotprecincts.com</u> your voter registered name and address. You will be emailed your precinct map showing your precinct number, as well as your specific district numbers per sample page attached.
- 6. We will send your data to the Chair of your Assembly District to begin processing your precinct list of all registered voters in your precinct. Then you can begin making friends with your active Republican neighbors to introduce the grass roots precinct program.
- **7.** The following shows Trump accomplishments that you should keep in mind when making friends with other Republican voters in your precinct.
 - Middle class family income annual \$ gain in 3 years of Trump Leadership.
 - There was no gain in 8 years of Obama leadership.
 - The household wealth % gain by income grouping shows the true facts We predict by 2022 election voters will want to return to Republican leadership





The above shows the % change of each total ethnic voting population that have shifted to become part of the NEW REPUBLICAN PARTY. We expect more gains in future elections. This is the message that our **PATRIOT PRECINCT PROGRAM** is expecting to accomplish.

- 8. The assembly districts in each county is where the strategic planning is done for the county Republican party. The Grass Roots effort and organizing must be done at precinct neighborhood level.
- 9. When you are appointed precinct leader for the precinct in which you live you become eligible to be an associate member of YOUR assembly district. Every Assembly district has 7 delegates elected every 4 years which are all voting members of the Republican county party. Each delegate also appoints an alternate county party member to attend county meeting and vote on issues. As a precinct leader you are eligible to apply for associate membership in your assembly district. You may also run for election as a county delegate at any 4 year primary presidential election.

- 10. For your first contacts, select 4 or 5 of the most active republican voters. Find common ground for conversation. Provide them your contact phone and email info before you ask for theirs. You want to first learn what your neighbors views are, not to express your own views, unless asked. You are developing a long term relationship with a new group of friends.
- 11. Once you have an interested Republican group that wants to stay informed, meet on a regular basis . Find other common causes in your city or community that need attention from city officials. School and safety issues are primary concerns in all cities and neighborhoods. So there are plenty of common issues where you can both give and get support for action.
- 12. One of your tasks is to make sure all legal voters are registered. Once you receive your registration list please walk or drive the precinct streets and note any address not listed. After meeting your most active voting GOP neighbor, show them addresses on their block not registered. Give them the conservative v. liberal comparison on 5 federal issues. Ask them to help you find those in the neighborhood that need to be registered or re-registered.

This data below is available on line for every one of the 80 Assembly districts in CA. Suggest you compile data for your own districts including data on voting views of your current elected officials so you can keep your Republican friends in precinct properly informed.


